The 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> multi-grade teaching position is part of an elementary school covering all subjects (math, language arts, science, outdoor adventure, and PE). A successful candidate will be able to teach language arts (especially with some background in remedial reading instruction), math, and science. Abilities in other subject areas are welcome. As a co-teacher, duties will also include parent communication and managing individual student programs. Teachers are part of a dynamic, collaborative team, designing and delivering a developmentally responsive, integrated curriculum.

## Preferred Qualifications:

- Course work in Elementary Education
- 3-5 years of Early Elementary classroom or relevant teaching experience is expected.

- Multi-age classroom experience, or experience with a diverse range of learners, is especially helpful for this position.
