About the Position:

We seek creative and energetic Counselors for our Summer Camp which runs from June 24, 2024 -August 16, 2024. Ideal candidates will have a strong interest in child-centered learning, diversity, inclusion and educational access, as well as community/team building with our tight-knit staff. Our high quality, high energy summer programming attracts curious children and pre-teens looking for opportunities to explore and deepen their knowledge and experience in the visual and mechanical arts, performing arts and culture & cuisines. Camp Counselors sometimes support and sometimes lead this exploration while providing a daily and weekly frame-work in which their campers experience a sense of belonging, safety and summertime fun! Priority will be given to applicants who can commit to all 4 sessions of Camp, but flexible work schedules are also available. Schedule and Start Date:

Priority is given to candidates who can make the full 8 week commitment. Candidates who can make a 4 week commitment will also be considered. The position begins with Training Days in June.

Qualifications:

- Demonstrated enthusiasm for teaching, and creating meaningful connection with, young children and teens required
- History of work/school experience with children in 3rd through 9th grade, and/or history of work/school experience in the following areas, coupled with a desire to teach, lead and connect: Visual & Mechanical Arts, Performing Arts, Culture & Cuisines



- Ability to embrace fast-paced summer time work in all weather conditions
- Demonstrated ability to engage in positive relationships with other staff, supervisors and campers required.
- Ability to be flexible, work collaboratively and plan with other teachers/counselors, and support the program as a whole
- Ability to lead projects and lessons, and/or the desire to learn this skill
